Another Local New York State Tree for New York City's Largest Holiday Festival 27 Foot Holiday Tree for 17th Annual Winter's Eve at Lincoln Square Gets Cut!

In tradition, local elected officials will join Domes Tree Farm owners to cut a holiday tree for the 17th Annual Winter's Eve at Lincoln Square, New York's largest holiday festival. The Lincoln Square Business Improvement District is thrilled to once again support New York state tree farmers. The tree will get cut and prepared for its journey to New York City at Domes Tree Farm, located in Bliss, New York on Thursday, November 10th at 11:00am. This New York born and raised Concolor Fir is 27 feet tall and nearly 15 feet across. Domes Tree Farm is a family-owned business that's been in operation since 1952, and is part of a vibrant agricultural economy in rural Wyoming County, southeast of Buffalo. Current owners Bill and Katie Domes specialize in tree-moving farm machinery which will prepare the tree for its long journey. The tree will be unloaded and installed at Dante Park (Broadway between 63rd and 64th Streets) by the New York City Department of Parks & Recreation on the morning of Monday, November 14th.

The tree will be the festival's center piece and features LED lights generously donated by Lowe's Home Improvement as well as old-fashioned silver glass glitter ornaments by Wendy Addison and Tinsel Trading. The tree will be on display through January 2017. Winter's Eve at Lincoln Square is set for Monday, November 28th, 2016 from 5:30 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. and begins with the Upper West Side's only tree lighting ceremony on the main stage at Dante Park.
